International scientific e-conference



The climate crisis is one of the biggest challenges in the modern world. Time had passed when ecology was only in the agendas of so-called ecological organizations (so-called green). Today, the topic of climate change (even climate catastrophe), ecology, climate protection appears in virtually every environment - including in the Churches. Therefore the Polish Ecumenical Council, the University of Lodz and the Christian Theological Academy invite you to participate in the Scientific e-Conference Eco(Theo)Logically - Christians in the face of challenges.

The conference will refer to the views of, e.g. a figure such as Albert Schweitzer, who was a Lutheran priest, theologian, philosopher, musician and humanist, promoting the word and deed the slogan "worship for life". The philosophy and ethics of this scholar, Nobel laureate and practice of medicine can be of great importance to modern ecology due to its multidimensionality and interdisciplinary nature.

The conference will take place in the form of a digital meeting on the Z00M communication platform on the 5th of November, 2020.

The key speakers at the conference will be Bishop Marcin Hintz, Prof. Jarosław Płuciennik from Poland, Prof. Hans Diefenbacher from Germany, Archbishop Antje Jackelén from Sweden and Prof. James Nicholas Carleton Paget from the United Kingdom. Official representatives of the organizers will open the conference.

We invite all students, doctoral students, academics in the field of broadly understood humanities, philosophy, theology, ecological sciences, as well as theological and environmental activists whose interests concern the subject of the conference.

The proposals must comply with the substantive scope of the conference, i.e. theology, philosophy, ethics and culture concerning the environment. The conference organizers reserve the exclusive right to evaluate and select the submitted papers.

Selected papers will be presented during the conference in the format of 18-minute speeches. The papers delivered at the conference are scheduled to be published, so speakers will be required to provide the organizers at the end of the conference with drafted texts of not less than 18,000 characters without spaces.

Conference languages: Polish, German, English. Simultaneous translations guaranteed for plenary speakers. The discussions in the sections will be linguistically themed.
